Background/History:

Regulation 298: Operation of Schools – General, Section 21, refers to Appointment to Teach in Case of an Emergency. Section 21 states:

21. (1) Where no teacher is available, a board may appoint, subject to section 22, a person who is not a teacher or a temporary teacher. R.R.O. 1990, Reg. 298, s. 21 (1).

(2) A person appointed under subsection (1) shall be 18 years of age or older and hold an Ontario secondary school diploma, a secondary school graduation diploma or a secondary school honour graduation diploma, or an equivalent to any of them. O. Reg. 29/08, s. 2.

(3) An appointment under this section is valid for ten school days commencing with the day on which the person is appointed. R.R.O. 1990, Reg. 298, s. 21 (3).

Current Situation:

Each year we have cases within our schools where a teacher or temporary teacher is not available and someone needs to be appointed who is not qualified for a period of less than ten days. This normally happens in the spring when new teachers graduate but are not yet fully qualified through the Ontario College of Teachers. If we do not have a qualified occasional teacher available we call these new graduates and use them as outlined in Regulation 298. This motion is passed at the September Board Meeting every year giving the responsibility to the Director of Education to appoint an unqualified person to teach in an emergency situation when no qualified teacher is available.

Budgetary/Financial Consideration:

There are no budgetary considerations for this item.

Communications Plan:

Communication of this decision will take place through the minutes of the regular Board Meeting which are posted on the website and available in printed form.

Recommendations:

It is recommended that the trustees of the Kenora Catholic District School Board approve the motion to authorize the Director of Education to invoke, as required, the emergency procedure outlined in Regulation 298 section 21.
