Superintendent Alison Smith delivered the 2022-2023 Internal Audit Committee Report, summarizing the past fiscal year's activities and achievements, including completed audits in areas of maintenance, school-generated funds, and performance appraisal. 9.5.2 2023 – 2024 Revised Estimates – Alison Smith

Alison Smith, Superintendent of Business, Facilities, and Planning Services provided a review of the 2023 – 2024 Revised Estimates based on the October 31, 2023, enrolment report. The board's projected enrolment was 1,260 students, and the actual enrolment as of October 31 is 1,284 students, which is an increase of 24 students. The annual deficit is projected to be \$336,661 which is compliant with legislation. Smith reported that the majority of the deficit is attributed to inflation, utilities, and increases in benefit costs.
